RM 242 R. 242 Mile Canyon- Nice Hike

RM 243.0 R - 243 Mile Camp

RM 246.2 L - Spencer Canyon

RM 248.7 R - Surprise Canyon, Big Beach, most likely it is two camps

RM 250.0 R - 250 Mile Camp (aka Tomahawk), last real camp before Quartermaster canyon.

RM 260 L A steep beach with plenty of room in the tammies. It is El-Centro helicopter zone. Beware. A few nice small beaches just below too.

RM 264 R Dry Canyon, small beach.

RM 265 Sand Bar Island, in the middle of the river. It will disappear in high water. You can see the SkyWalk from here on river left.

RM268 L, 269 L, 269.4 R * All are small, might just work.

RM 271.2 Evans Heaven, an awesome hike to spectacular small waterfalls. Sand stairs are cut thru the sand bank. Camp is on top.

This is a must stop if you haven't been to this side canyon
