



# 18' Boat Rigging Tips!

**Ceiba's 18' boats** carry a 205 Qt Canyon Cooler, six 20mm cans in each drop bag &/or milk crates, propane tanks, soda pop / beer

**Ceiba's Rig Bag** is included with all of our full rigs & contains:

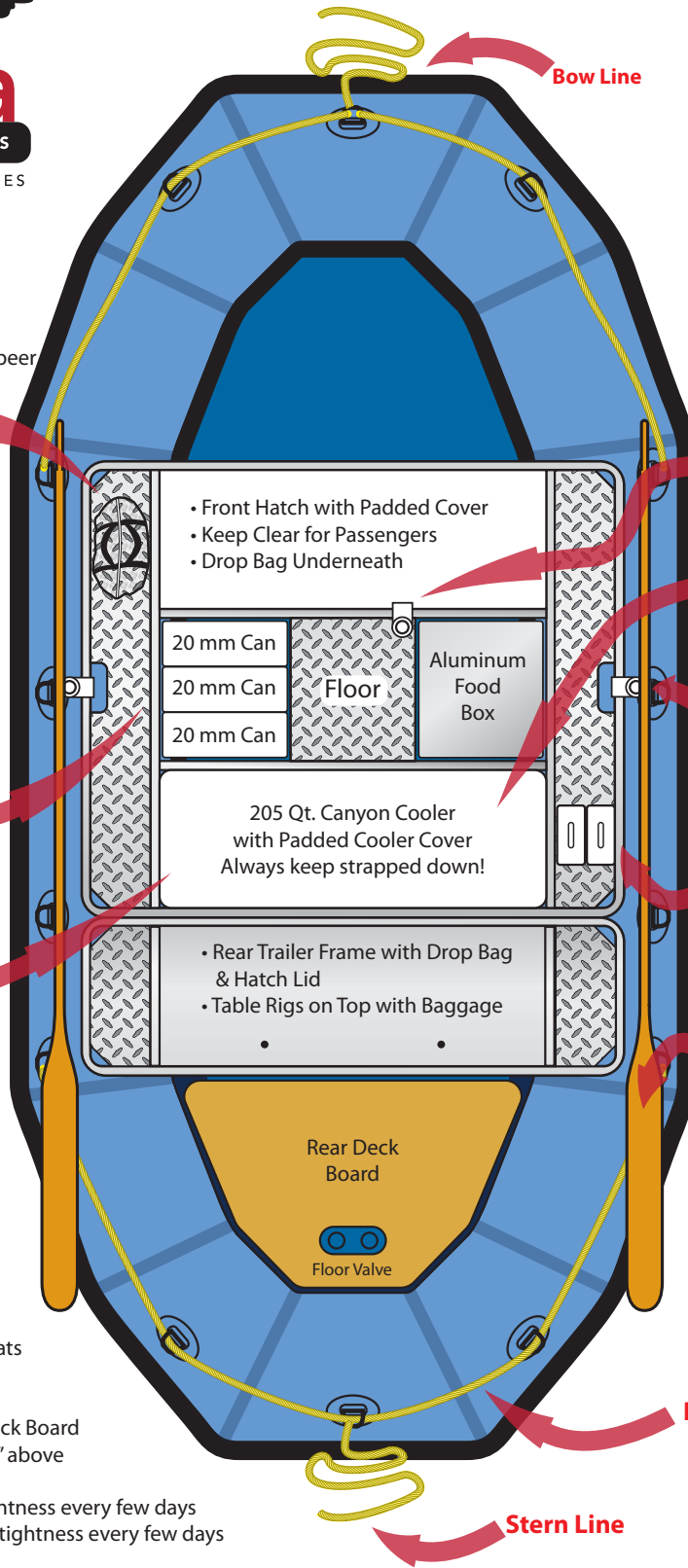
- 15 Extra Rigging Straps
- 1 Type IV Throw Cushion
- 1 Throw Bag
- 3 Oar Stands & Locks
- Sand Anchor & Hammer
- Drag Bag for beverages
- Custom Woody Allen!

**3 - 20mm cans** or 1 Aluminum Box can fit on either side of the floor

**All of Ceiba's 18' Boats** come with the best cooler made: The 205 Qt Canyon Cooler & cooler cover!

**TIPS:**

- Rinse feet off before getting on the boat
- Please do not write on boats
- No Duct Tape please
- Keep sand out of valves
- Aluminum floor & Rear Deck Board should be rigged about 1" above the Self-Bailing floor
- Check frame straps for tightness every few days
- Check your oar stands for tightness every few days



All of Ceiba's frames come pre-rigged with the appropriate 1½" & 1" straps. It makes it fast and easy!

Additional gear supplied with all 18' full rigs:

- 1 Barrel "air" Pump
- 1 Repair Kit
- Bail Bucket
- 1 Aluminum Table
- Rear Deck Board (optional)

**Optional** Umbrella Holder & Umbrella

**This is where the boatman sits**

**Oar Stands** are located in the middle of the raft with your choice of open locks, oar rights or pins & clips

**50 Cal Ammo Cans** can be rigged on all corners of the main frame

**Spare Oars** on Each Side Rigged with Existing 1" Straps to Side of Frame

**An option:** A Sleep Plate will bridge the gap between the boxes on the floor if two people want to sleep side by side on the boat.

**Rig to flip!** This is a common saying in the Grand Canyon. Most of the time it is said in jest while having fun rigging boats in the early morning hours before shoving off for the day. But deep down all boatmen know there is a certain amount of truth spoken each time the phrase passes the lips of a Grand Canyon boater. With good reason too! The last thing any boater wants in a flip is a "junk show" or "yard sale". As we all know, anything can happen and the sayings are endless!

We recommend rigging to flip every morning. The diagram above can help you and your teammates throughout your adventure. The diagram is an over view of the boat, what it is equipped to hold, placement for gear and general tips for keeping a safe, fun and clean rig!
